PREMISE:

- **ALIGN** yourself with God's dream for your life
- Allow **TIME** for your dream to be fulfilled

1. DREAMS TAKE FLIGHT

A. Aligning the dream

- Abraham became the father of many nations as God had promised. He had to align himself with the Word of God: he saw, he acted, and it came to pass.
- Align yourself with the dream of God.
- When your dream becomes your new normal, you no longer doubt God's ability to do miracles. Each day He is partnering with you as an active part of your life.

B. Developing patience

- It took years for Ceitci to see the fruit of seeds and prayers planted in childhood and young adulthood. She was able to be part of a history-making moment. You can too!
- Dreams take flight when we have God on our side.

TAKE TIME TO THINK AND DISCOVER:

As you complete the experiential imagery exercise and the personal reflection questions, keep these thoughts in mind:

- Defining our dreams by physically writing them down helps our mind to register the reality of those dreams.
- The act of writing can solidify our dream more effectively than viewing our notes or photos electronically. The neuron in our brain creates a pathway by the way we touch, feel, and see.
- Journaling, posting pictures on the fridge, and using a vision board can also be helpful.
- Some dreams are for a season, others are for a lifetime. Take time to distinguish between the ones that are more immediate and can be achieved in the next few years and those to which you are called for a lifetime.
- Categorize your dreams: family, business, vacation, health, travel, ministry, etc. As you rate your progress, use the scale as a reference point to chart your success and keep yourself accountable.
- As you reflect on identifying qualities of those you admire and find you can't pinpoint a person in your life to use as an example, think of people in the Bible, especially Jesus. If you're using God as an example, you can never run out of qualities to admire and adopt!
- Also look at the qualities of those around you. Your RAS will begin to illuminate people who are coming into your pathway and will open your eyes to new things you can learn from them.
