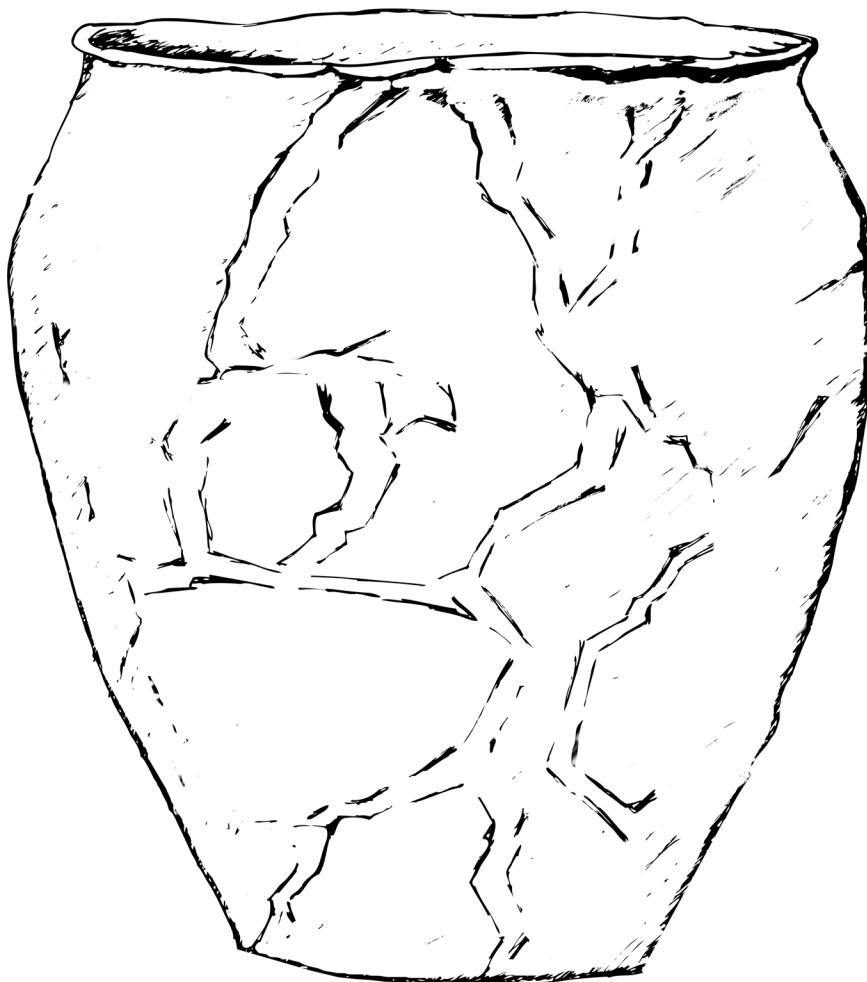


AN EXPERIENTIAL IMAGERY EXERCISE

PRINCIPLE
